2020 LITTLE LEAGUE® INTERNATIONAL PLAYER RESIDENCY AND SCHOOL ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS

For a child to be a Little Leaguer®, eligibility must first be established by way of residency inside the boundaries of a local Little League®, or the location of the school where the child attends is located inside a local league's boundaries that is approved by Little League Baseball, Incorporated.

Option 1: School Attendance Eligibility Requirements:

School attendance shall be established and supported by a document indicating enrollment for the current academic year, dated prior to October 1, 2019, and with the physical location of the school, from ONE of the following categories to determine school attendance by such player:

- 1. Official/Certified school enrollment record dated prior to October 1, 2019
- 2. A Little League-issued school attendance form completed by the principal, assistant principal, or administrator authorized to sign on behalf of the school

Option 2: Residency Eligibility Requirements:

Residence shall be established and supported by documents containing the full residence which includes parent(s) or guardian(s) name, street address, city, state and zip code information, dated or in force between February 1, 2019 (previous year) and February 1, 2020 (current year), from one or more documents from EACH of the three Groups outlined below:

Group I – ONE Document Dated or active Between 2/1/2019 and 2/1/2020

- 1. Driver's License (photo ID of parent(s) or guardian(s) with residence address)
- 2. School records (home address of player's parents or guardians)
- 3. Vehicle records (i.e., registration, lease, etc.)
- 4. Employment records
- 5. Insurance documents (with residence address)

Group II – ONE Document Dated or active Between 2/1/2019 and 2/1/2020

- 1. Welfare/child care records
- 2. Federal records (i.e., Federal Tax, Social Security, etc.)
- 3. State records
- 4. Local (municipal) records
- 5. Support payment records
- 6. Homeowner or tenant records
- 7. Military records

Group III – ONE Document Dated or active Between 2/1/2019 and 2/1/2020

- 1. Voter's Registration
- 2. Utility bills (i.e., gas, electric, water/sewer, phone, mobile phone, heating, waste disposal)
- 3. Financial records (loan, credit, investments, etc.)
- 4. Medical records
- 5. Internet, cable, or satellite television records

NOTE: Example – Three documents from the same Group (utility bill, cable bill, and bank statement) constitute only ONE document.

The District and the local league will maintain this form and supporting documentation in their files. Completion of this form is only required ONCE during a participant's career, unless the school enrollment changes. A II(d) would then be required.
